The City of Ruston's smart-grid energy management system will develop a fully functioning Smart Grid by improving customer systems, automating electricity distribution, and deploying a smart meter network and data management system, according to the DOE description of the ARRA [Smart Grid Investment Grant](#) awarded to the City.

According to the statement of work, the City of Ruston's project target results include:

- 1,287,994 KWH renewable energy generation
- Fuel reduction of 7,500 gallons
- A 5% energy reduction overall for customers
- A 50% reduction of distribution interruptions
- An estimated community cost savings of over \$5,266,674
